GVC and Cromwell Valley Park Council Board Member, Carl Gold, led the hikers from the Sherwood House down along the Lime Kiln trail to the Minebank Run Trail and back. We learned about some of the history and ecology at the park while having fun.

Right before the hike, GVC leadership announced that we unlocked our \$10,000 match!! Our end of year fundraising total surpassed \$40,000 and was our largest to date. In short, a wonderful way to kick off our 35th Year.
