

Functional Flora



Conservation gardens are often praised for their ability to provide habitat for pollinators, such as butterflies and birds. The benefits, however, extend to all types of wildlife, as homeowners on Sue Creek recently discovered. This spring, they noticed that a painted turtle had chosen their rain garden—installed by Gunpowder Valley Conservancy (GVC) in 2021—as a nesting site! They kept an eye on the garden throughout the summer and helped the hatchlings (pictured above) make their way to Sue Creek.

Upstream from the baby turtles, we have another story that showcases functional flora in the Gunpowder Watershed. Welcome to Marc Hauptman's property in suburban Towson, which is now a poster child for stormwater management landscaping.



Marc initiated a relationship with GVC a few years ago to address a problem. "I was getting a lot of erosion. I took down a lot of big trees...that created more water runoff than what I was getting before," Marc shared, "Plus, the ground being compact and this clay soil...[I needed help with the erosion.]"


Speak For the Streams
