Reducing Pollution on Providence Road



This month, GVC officially kicked off our year-long Bay-Wise Project at Divinity Lutheran located at 1220 Providence Road. Nestled among mature forest and homes, the church already has a strong connection with the outdoors. We look forward to working in partnership with Interfaith Partners for the Chesapeake to reduce stormwater runoff on the property AND nurture a new community of environmental stewards. We will also be working with Baltimore County Master Gardeners to achieve Bay-Wise Certification for the Divinity Lutheran Church campus.

We began our meeting with a shared blessing ("Water Unites Us All") to *bpen* our minds and hearts to heal our disconnect from the sacred waters of the Chesapeake Bay Watershed...our shared home." We hope to repair that disconnect by engaging the church community, affiliated garden club members, neighbors, and high school students at a variety of free educational workshops, including a rain barrel sale and Bayscape installation.

Stayed tuned for more details about how we'll be updating the area around their outdoor chapel. The Bay-Wise Project at Divinity Lutheran is primarily funded by a Chesapeake Bay Trust's Outreach and Restoration Grant.
